IF YOU LIKE TEMPRANILLO...

27. Rioja Crianza, El Coto, Spain £19.80

Raspberry fruits and soft spicy flavours. Creamy with lovely vanilla notes after oak aging for twelve months. Awarded 90 points in the 'Guia Penin' (The Penin Guide), Spain's most respected annual wine book.

28. Rioja Gran Reserva, Coto de Imaz Spain £27.00

Gold Medal in the recent 'Rioja Masters' tasting held by The Drinks Business Magazine. A complex nose of dark fruit and traces of Mocha and spices. Succulent with a round velvety finish.

IF YOU LIKE PINOT NOIR...

29. Lagrange Le Haut, Domaine Virginie, Vin de Pays de L'Hérault, France £19.10

A stylish Pinot Noir. Warm cherry fruit with good depth and concentration.

30. Gevrey-Chambertin, Domaine Rossignol-Trapet, Burgundy, France £45.00

Family owned vineyards since the 16th Century. This Pinot Noir is from one of the best Grand Crus Vineyards in Burgundy. An intensely seductive nose of raspberries, cherries, figs with hints of chocolate, leather and vanilla. An immensely pleasing wine.

IF YOU LIKE MALBEC...

31. Alta Vista Classic, Mendoza, Argentina £17.80

Big powerful dark wine with spicy aromas of ripe red fruit and liquorice on the palate.

32. Grande Reserve, Terroir Selection, Alta Vista, Mendoza, Argentina £32.00

Alta Vista is rated in the top 5 of all the Argentine wineries by Robert Parker. A blend of wines from their four top single vineyards. This powerful inky wine is garnet-red with spicy aromas and violet. Minty and with terrific concentration. Trophy winner at the Argentina Wine Awards 2014.

IF YOU LIKE UNUSUAL REDS...

33. Montepulciano D' Abruzzo, Villa Borghetti, Pasqua, Italy £15.90

Ripe, rounded and deliciously spicy fruit.

34. Barolo, Manfredi, Piedmonte, Italy £39.00

Warming, intense and well balanced. Massive. Not for wimps!

35. Claret, Château Moulinet Lasserre, Pomerol, France £39.50

Mature, supple and big boned Merlot based claret.

TIME TO SHARE...

36. Chablis 1er Cru, Montmains, Brocard, Burgundy, France £65.00

Excellent premier cru Chablis, crisp and refined, with citrusy substance and smooth creaminess. Very much a tradition of precisely expressing a fascinating array of terroirs.

37. Claret, Château Angludet, Cru Bourgeois, Margaux, Bordeaux, France £83.50

This wine has a very dark character aromatically, concentrated. The palate is the rich and creamy, polished, with a great tannic backbone to it. Very impressive.

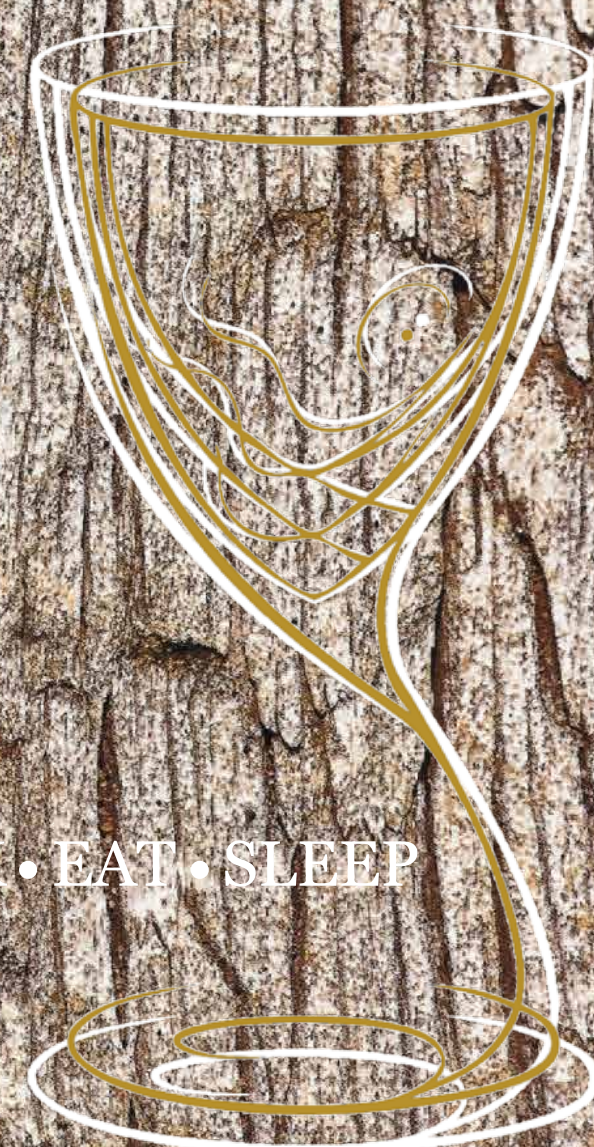

38. Muscat, All Saints, Victoria, Australia £9.80 £3.95

Liqueur dark Muscat. Provocatively perfumed with deep layers of sweet butterscotch and honey. International Wines and Spirits Challenge 2015 Gold Medal winner.

39. Tokaji Aszu 5 Puttonyos, Hungary £13.75 £5.60

The Tokaj wine region is in north east Hungary and boasts the world's first vineyard classification originating in the 17th century. A luscious, concentrated sweet wine from Hungary. It is richly complex with a palate of honey, dried apricots and hazelnuts and a tangy orange marmalade finish.

- 1. Prosecco, Brut Spumante, Pasqua, Non Vintage, Italy** **£6.50**
Single Serve 18.7cl bottles 6.50
Dry, light, easy-drinking bubbly from north-east Italy, in the region of Veneto.
Glass and a half again of fizzy fun.
- 2. Prosecco, Brut Spumante, Revino, Non Vintage, Italy** **£19.00**
With tangy apple and peach scents. Made from the Glera.
- 3. Cava, Bohigas Reserva, Brut, Non Vintage Spain** **£22.00**
A dry, mineral-driven Cava from a family-owned estate in the River Anoia Valley.
Quality, Champagne method, resulting in very fine, long-lasting bubbles.
- 4. Champagne, Cockburn and Campbell Selected Cuvee, Brut, Non Vintage, France** **£38.00**
Sourced from the excellent Beaumont des Crayères. The blend is fresh and crisp, whilst keeping the lovely mature elements that bottle age gives.

- 5. Bollinger, Champagne, Brut, Special Cuvée, Champagne, France** **£60.00**
Produced with high proportion of Pinot Noir to give Bollinger its unique depth and structure, this is a great Champagne that can count James Bond among its fans.
- 6. Champagne, Laurent-Perrier, Brut, Non Vintage, France** **£81.00**
From one of the Champagne's best known producers, this classic Champagne is light and elegant with subtle yeasty and buttery characteristics.

WHITE WINES**IF YOU LIKE SAUVIGNON BLANC...**

- 7. Paso del Sol, Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile** **£16.90**
Powerful aromatic nose with dry ripe gooseberry and grapefruit flavours. Sommelier Wine Awards 2014 – Gold Medal.
- 8. New Zealand, Sauvignon Blanc, Mission, Marlborough** **£22.50**
Superb wine with wonderful crisp freshness and zing. Aromas of freshly mown grass and hints of lychee.
- 9. Pouilly-Fumé Les Moulins, Caves de Pouilly, Loire, France** **£26.00**
Grown in limestone-rich, chalky soil. Pouilly-Fume has mineral flavours and a distinct flint character due to the fossil rich and mineral soil.
- 10. Sancerre, Les Jeannettes, Etienne de Loury, Loire, France** **£32.50**
This is a classic example of Sauvignon Blanc. Crisp, fresh gooseberry and grapefruit flavours.

IF YOU LIKE CHARDONNAY...

- 11. Clockmaker, Chardonnay, South Australia** **£15.80**
Medium dry with ripe pineapple fruit flavours.
- 12. Chablis, Domaine Sainte Claire, Jean-Marc Brocard, Burgundy, France** **£28.50**
This world-famous white wine from Burgundy exudes class and style.
Elegant with subtle lemony fruit and flinty, mineral flavours.

- 13. Pinot Grigio, Pavia, Villa Borghetti, Italy** **£16.80**
Delightful wine from Veneto. Dry and refreshing with a hint of almond on the finish.

IF YOU LIKE UNUSUAL WHITES...

- 14. Chenin Blanc, Keate's Drift, Western Cape, South Africa** **£16.80**
This rounded medium wine has hints of melon fruit.
- 15. Vinho Verde Monção, Portugal** **£16.00**
Made with local Alvarinho grapes - is steely dry with a lovely refreshing spritz.
- 16. Riesling, Erdener Treppchen Kabinett, Richter, Mosel, Germany** **£28.50**
Off dry with a zippy, elderflower flavour.
- 17. Pinot Blanc D'Alsace, Pfaffenhiem, France** **£22.00**
Soft, sprightly and full of fresh fruit.

3 SHADES OF PINK...

- 18. Pinot Grigio, Rosé, Villa Borghetti, Italy** **£15.90**
A pleasant, balanced, harmonious and fruity wine of good structure with floral notes and hints of pear and apricot.
- 19. Zinfandel Rosé, Clockmaker, California** **£15.90**
Medium dry with ripe red fruit on the palate.
- 20. Sancerre, Les Jeannettes Rosé, Etienne de Loury, Loire, France** **£33.00**
Gentle rosé made from the red Pinot Noir grape.

RED WINES**IF YOU LIKE SHIRAZ/SYRAH...**

- 21. Clockmaker Shiraz, South Australia** **£15.80**
Ripe, peppery fruit.
- 22. Syrah, Smart Dog, JP Ramos, Alentejo, Portugal** **£18.00**
A wine of real character. With notes of lavender, chocolate and spices. Rich and robust, with ripe tannins.
- 23. Beresford, Maclaren Vale, South Australia** **£28.50**
Ripe red. Full of black fruit and chocolate flavours with a spicy peppery finish, which pairs particularly well with steak.
- 24. Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine Font de Michelle, Rhone Valley, France** **£39.00**
Jean and Michel Gonnet, Font de Michelle Cousins are near neighbours of the Bruniers of Vieux Télégraphe fame. Super wine from a top estate, an ancient Roman site where there was a spring : "La Fontaine de Michelle". A wine with a fragrant, red berry fruit nose which is followed by an explosion of ripe fruit on the front of the palate, fresh acidity and silky tannins.

IF YOU LIKE MERLOT...

- 25. La Borie, Pays D' Oc, France** **£16.90**
Soft red with plummy notes from the south of France. Delicious.
- 26. Claret, Château Puy Blanquet, Grand Cru St Emilion, France** **£32.00**
A delightful wine, predominantly Merlot, with intense fruit on the nose followed by lovely red cherry flavours on the palate, with juicy character and soft tannins on the finish.

Wines available by the glass.
